### Vladimir G. Kossobokov elected foreign fellow of Accademia XL



Vladimir G. Kossobokov, member of the scientific advisory board of our pJWG-NDSHA, has been elected as foreign fellow of the Accademia Nazionale Delle Scienze detta dei XL (<a href="https://www.accademiaxl.it/">https://www.accademiaxl.it/</a>). Prof. Kossobokov is the chief scientist of the Russian Academy of Sciences (RAS), Moscow. He has a wide range of research interests, including but not limited to exploratory data analysis, pattern recognition, applied mathematical statistics, global and regional geophysical databases, earthquake prone areas, reproducible methods for intermediate-term earthquake prediction, and hazard and risk assessment. Prof. Kossobokov has been the life member of the American Geophysical Union (AGU) since 1991, member of the European Advisory Evaluation

Committee for Earthquake Prediction, Council of Europe since 1999, and Core Member of the International Seismic Safety Organization since 2011. He is the past Vice President of the IUGG Commission on Geophysical Risk and Sustainability (GRC).
